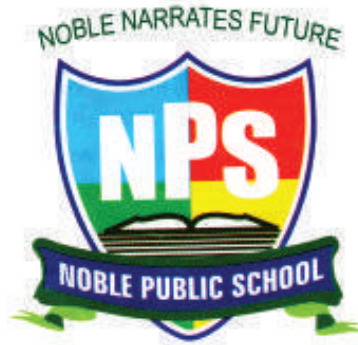

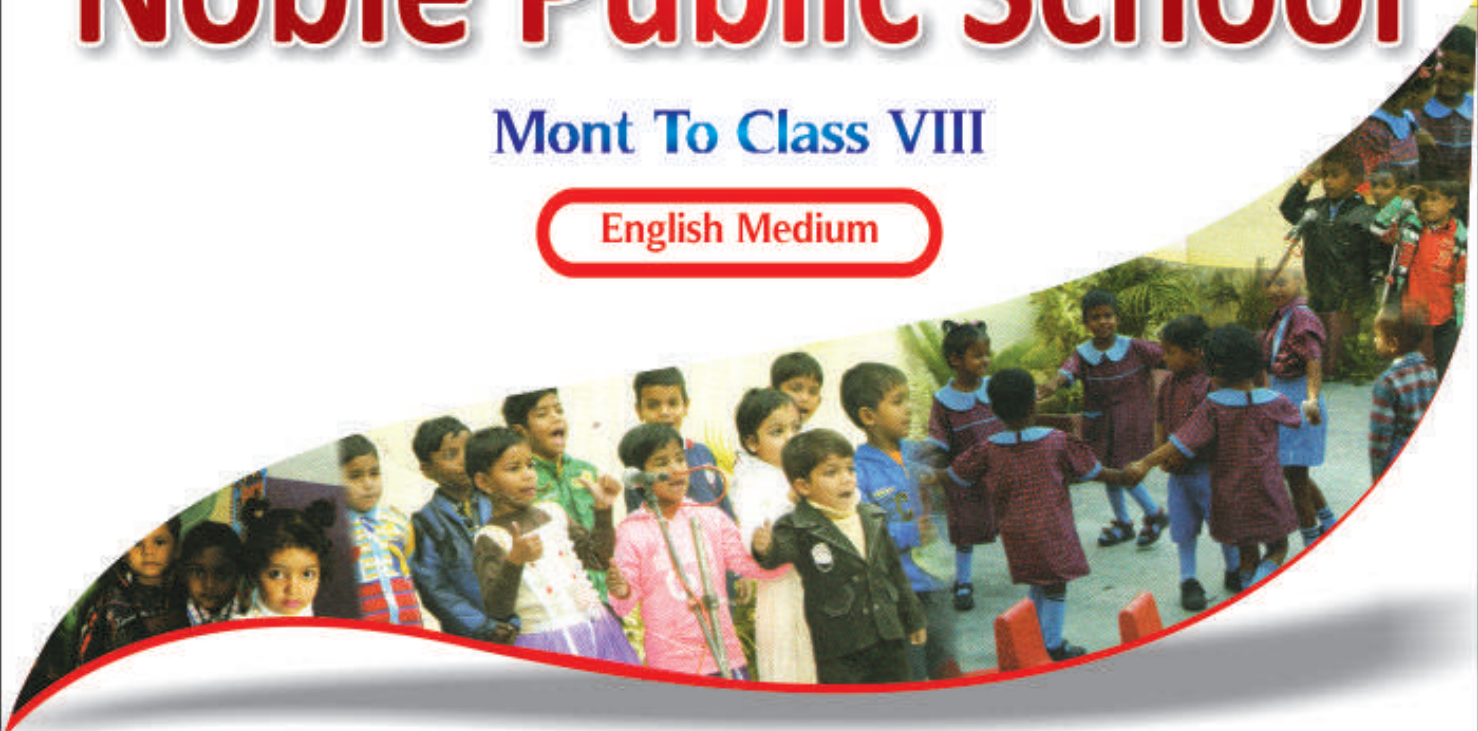

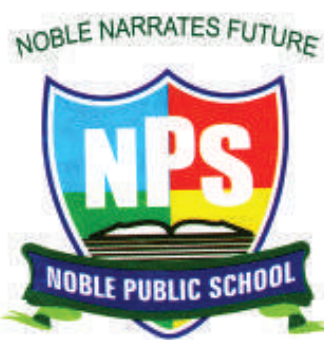

DEAR PARENTS,

The academic year.....has a heady commenced.

We thank you for your co-operation in the past and seek the some in the future too. Children can improve and perform up to a certain level with the help of regular assessment and by following the points mentioned below.

1. Each class will have two tests a day during the schedule dates.
2. Oral tests will only be to assess the child's regularity in studies.
3. No re –test will be conducted. Children will not be allowed to give the test on paper.
4. Marks will be deducted for spelling errors and grammatical mistakes in all subjects.
5. Children should be in school five minutes before the time mentioned.
6. Children should bring proper tiffin and water bottles(No canteen)
7. Diaries and test copies to be signed regularly only by the parents.
8. Fee to be paid by 1 to 15th of each month.
9. Girls should tie their hair in a plait, clip their nails regularly and wear knee – length socks.
10. Boys should wear a white vest under their shirt, regularly get their hair cut and nail should be clipped at regular interval.
11. No half-days will be allowed.
12. Parents are requested to keep in regular touch with the teachers. If your ward requires so.
13. Parents can meet the class teacher/subject teacher only day during the week after taking appointment through diary.(but after the classes get over)
14. A fine of Rs.10/- will be charged if buttons are missing on the shirts in summer and the blazers in the winters, if the child is in shabby uniform with torn pockets , missing buttons , no tie or belt or polished shoes.
15. The children will change over to the summer uniform after Holi and winter uniform from 1st November.

IMPORTANT COUNCIL REGULATIONS

1. A Child must clear in all the subjects in order to get the promotion to next class.
2. There will be system of Re-examination.
3. 75% of attendance is compulsory otherwise the students can not appear in the Annual Examination.

IMPORTANCE NOTES FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

1. Every student must bring his/her diary to school every day.
2. Students will not be allowed to attend classes without proper uniform.
3. Students should attend school regularly and punctually.

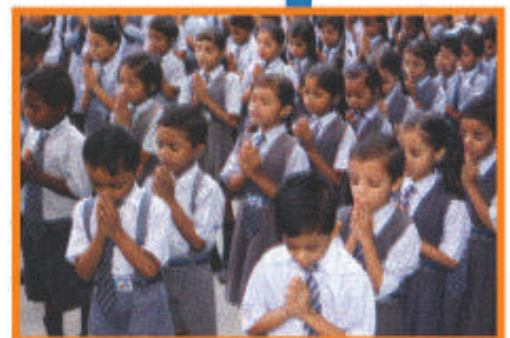
